For 2, 4 and 10-Pay Plans, sign up for Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) in the Insured Service Center to have installment fees waived. Fees vary by state and payment plan.

Markel PayGo has the lowest down payment amount of any of the pay plans. The premium collected is based on actual, not estimated, payroll. Premiums can be paid weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly depending on the insured's payroll frequency. Markel PayGo accepts payroll data from the insured's payroll/accounting systems and the majority of payroll providers. A payroll reporting net rate is used to calculate the premium.

Monthly Self Reporting⁴	15%	Insureds with premiums over \$2,500 qualify for Monthly Self Reporting. The insureds would pay a 15% deposit in most states. The deposit will be held as long as the insured is a customer. Payroll is reported in Markel's mPortal Insured Service Center. The insured simply pays the calculated premium directly to Markel monthly. A monthly reporting net rate is used to calculate the premium.
Xpress Premium Finance 11-Pay	18%	Conveniently combine all policy payments into one. Xpress Premium Finance helps the insured manage cash flow by spreading their payments throughout the policy term with one fixed monthly installment payment.
